## **Marble Paintings**

#### **DIY Lazer Maze**



# **Vocational Success:**

## A Timeline of Adam's Journey to Employment

**October 2018:** Adam started his journey with Sky Point Social Services receiving Employment Services as referred by Vocational Rehabilitation.

**February 2019:** Adam began the volunteer program at Parkview Hospital where he cleaned the nurse's stations and completed other general cleaning tasks in order to learn job skills during Discovery. The Discovery process consists of doing work experiences or volunteer experiences to determine the vocational theme of the individual to ensure success in future careers.

**September 2019:** Employment Services Manager, Cathy Roberts, had an informational meeting with the one of the owners of Deister Concentrator, Donald Ross. During this meeting, Cathy and Donald spoke about the needs of Deister and the many strengths of individuals with disabilities.



What is Deister? For over 110 years, Deister Concentrator has been one of the leading manufacturers of equipment for the mineral, coal processing, and waste water industries. Besides the lab size shaking tables, Deister Concentrator

also manufactures and sells single, double, and triple deck concentrating tables as well as a complete line of heavy media and classifying cyclones, sieve bends, heated screens, and hydraulic classifiers.

During the meeting, Cathy and Donald discussed the staffing needs at Deister and Donald inquired if Sky Point had any individuals that could fill that need. At that point, Cathy immediately thought of Adam and shared his abilities and many strengths with Donald. That night, Cathy spoke with Adam and shared the opportunity with him and Adam completed an application. Adam was very excited about the opportunity of a full-time position with satisfactory pay and benefits.

**October 2019:** Adam was offered, accepted, and started his new position at Deister. In this position, Adam would be responsible for painting with a brush and roller on wood and cast-iron parts, cleaning material prior to painting, sanding wooden products before and after painting to remove imperfections, placing items in storage, cleaning his work area, and parts assembly.

January 2020: Adam, his supervisor Josh, and Cathy met for his 90-day evaluation; where Josh commented that Adam was performing well and has not missed a day of work or had been late. At that point, Adam was then officially welcomed into the Deister family.
