To whom it may concern,

This individual is a staff member of Sky Point Social Services, LLC. and provides direct care services to individuals with disabilities and is considered an essential worker by Indiana Governor Eric Holcomb as seen below in the Executive Order:

“Human Services Operations”

The phrase “Human Services Operations” includes, but is not limited to, the following: long-term care facilities, day care centers, day care homes, group day care homes; residential settings and shelters for adults, seniors, children, and/or people with developmental disabilities, intellectual disabilities, substance use disorders, and/or mental illness; transitional facilities; home-based settings to provide services to individuals with physical, intellectual, and/or developmental disabilities, seniors, adults, and children; field offices that provide and help to determine eligibility for basic needs including food, case assistance, medical coverage, child care, vocational services, rehabilitation services; developmental centers; adoption agencies; business that provide food, shelter, and social services, and other necessities of life for economically disadvantaged individuals, individuals with physical, intellectual, and/or developmental disabilities, or otherwise needy individuals.

Further, the phrase “Human Services Operations” shall be construed broadly to avoid any impact to the delivery of human services, broadly defined.

This individual is a Direct Support Professional, Behavior Consultant, Wraparound Facilitator, or Employment Specialist and is authorized to continue providing services to individuals during the “Stay at Home” order from Indiana Governor Eric Holcomb.
